Johnston Canyon Icewalk

Trek through Johnston Canyon to a world of frozen waterfalls and pillars of blue ice. This Interpretive guided walk along the canyon bottom and over suspended catwalks leads you past waterfalls frozen in mid-stream, and through a short tunnel for a close up view of the Lower Falls! The grand finale is the incredible "Cathedral of Ice" at the Upper Falls. It's the perfect destination for a hot chocolate break and a chance to see ice climbers in action. The winter dogsled season is generally December to April, and is dependant upon snow & trail conditions. Howling Dog Tours will book tours in groups of 2-4 per sled (maximum 3 adults, or 2 adults and 2 children). All sleds are guided. Please Dress in warm winter gear (ski suits etc.), especially foot and head gear. We do not accept anyone in street shoes or running shoes. Howling Dog Tours reserves the right to turn away improperly dressed participants; no refund will be issued. Contact our office for more information.

Participants will be required to sign a waiver before departure; anyone under the age of 18 years must have a parent or guardian sign. Howling Dog Tours provides transportation to and from The Fairmont Banff Springs. Please be ready on time and look for our vans with the pink logo and paw prints on the side! *Please advise us if there are any children aged 2-5, as car seats are required.*

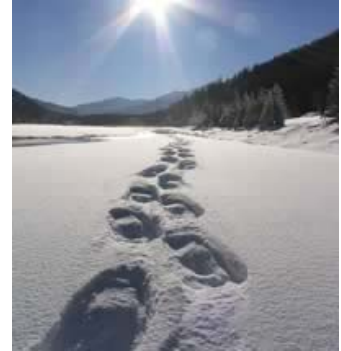
